

## **Vaccine for Children Update 11/3/2021 -**

**We are very pleased to announce that there will be a Covid vaccine clinic for children ages 5-11, to be held at Green Street School on Tuesday, November 9th between the hours of 9am-2pm.**

This vaccine clinic is being run by the VT Health Dept, with the approved Pfizer vaccine for children. This vaccine is recommended for all children ages 5-11, and is very safe and effective.

Students will be vaccinated with the support of the school nurse and other staff, and we will take very good care of them. Vaccine side effects for children are known to be much less severe than for adults.
