



# After School Program

2023 Winter/Spring Session



## Overview

The Green Street School after school programs are making a comeback. These programs provide a safe and engaging way for students to explore new hobbies/skills. The after school programs are offered to our students at no charge except for programs at the Boys and Girls Club. Supplies for each program are provided unless otherwise stated.

Green Street ASP's are on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3-4 pm.

An afternoon meal will be provided to all students participating in after school programs. If your child has any allergies, please be sure to indicate this on the registration form so that we can make accommodations.

All programs have a registration limit in terms of the number of students. Students will be accepted into programs on a first come, first served basis. Be sure to sign up online or send in the registration form as early as possible. We ask that you request a first and second choice of programs in case your first choice reaches capacity. Program enrollment will be communicated via email and a note sent home with your child the week prior to program start dates.

## Program Descriptions

### Card Games

Play some classic card games using a standard deck of cards. Games will include, but are not limited to Rummy, Crazy Eights, Go Fish, and War.

### Crochet

Students will learn the chain stitch and hopefully move on to crocheting a ball as a final project.

### Fun and Games

Come join us for fun and games after school! Each week we will offer a variety of activities to choose from including: board games, arts and crafts, legos, trains, and puzzles.

### Guitar Club

Guitar club will offer a chance for students to learn basic chords and easy strumming techniques for playing the guitar. Players will have a chance to try electric as well as acoustic guitars.

### Spa Time and Nails

Come have some relaxing time while we give each other manicures!

## Yoga

Taught by Registered Children's Yoga Teacher (RCYT). Students will engage in yoga poses, breath work and meditations . The class will follow a six week curriculum to help strengthen, develop flexibility and learn self care practices.

## Tutoring

Tutoring requires approval from your child's teacher. We will communicate with yourself and the teacher after registration is completed.
